Customer Notice – Schedule Delays Cap Papatele – Update No. 4

Dear Valued Customers,

Polynesia Line wishes to further update the situation around the Cap Papatele.

The Cap Papatele 942s has arrived in Honolulu for further inspections and repairs. Repairs and testing are tentatively scheduled to be completed by Friday February 14th. She will continue her southbound voyage to the Samoas with a current ETA in Apia and Pago Pago of February 21.

Based on the updated arrival dates, the Cap Papatele 944s call has been cancelled. All cargo currently booked on this vessel will be rolled to the Polynesia 516s. Her tentative schedule is as follows:

- ETD Long Beach – March 2
- ETD Oakland – March 4
- ETA Papeete – March 16
- ETA Apia – March 21
- ETA Pago Pago – March 21
- ETA Nuku'alofa – April 10
